Synopsis

Monsieur Harpagon loves money more than everything else in the world. He has buried a small box filled with a lot of money in his yard which he always fears to be stolen. However, he is such a miser that not even his children get any share of his treasure.

Meanwhile, Harpagon's son Cléante and daughter Élise have both fallen in love. But Harpagon wants Cléante's lover, the young and decent Marianne for himself and wants Élise to marry a rich old man named Anselme instead of Valère, Harpagon's steward. With the help of the cunning Madame Frosine, Cléante and Élise hatch a plot to make Harpagon give up his intentions so they can finally be happy. Harpagon isn't so easily fooled, though. He soon figures out Cléante's scheme and threatens to disown the boy for daring to speak against him.

In the play's final act, Cléante's valet—named La Flèche—digs up Harpagon's backyard treasure and makes off with it. Harpagon is desperate and calls the police. He demands the thief to be found and hanged. Cléante, however, assures Harpagon that he'll get his money back as soon as he agrees to let Cléante marry Marianne and to let Élise marry her lover Valère. But will their plan work out?

Handlung

Monsieur Harpagon liebt sein Geld mehr als alles andere auf der Welt. Er hat eine kleine Truhe voller Geld im Garten vergraben und fürchtet ständig, dass sie ihm irgendjemand stehlen könnte. Jedoch ist er so ein Geizkragen, dass nicht einmal seine Kinder etwas von seinem Geld abbekommen.

Derweilen haben sich sowohl sein Sohn, Cléante, als auch seine Tochter, Élise, verliebt. Aber Harpagon möchte die große Liebe seines Sohnes, die junge und anständige Marianne, selbst heiraten und befiehlt Élise den alten, aber reichen Monsieur Ansèlme statt Ihres geliebten Valère, Harpagons Haushofmeister, zu ehelichen. Mithilfe der berechnenden Madame Frosinehecken Cléante und Élise einen Plan aus, um Harpagon von seinen Absichten abzubringen, sodass sie beide ihr Glück finden können. Aber Harpagon lässt sich nicht so leicht hereinlegen und kommt dahinter. Er droht Cléante damit, ihn zu enterben, da dieser sich gegen ihn auflehnt.

Im letzten Akt findet Valères Dienerin, La Flèche, den Schatz im Garten und nimmt ihn an sich. Harpagon ist vollkommen verzweifelt und ruft die Polizei, von der er fordert, den Dieb zu finden und aufzuhängen. Cléante versichert Harpagon jedoch, dass er sein Geld dann zurückerhalten wird, wenn er den Heiratsplänen seiner Kinder zustimmt. Aber wird der Plan der Kinder aufgehen?
